Description

This course continues to develop on the concepts and ideas taught in Math 9. It builds on abilities to solve problems through manipulating equations and introduces new functions used to solve problems involving angles. Students taking this course tend to be interested in pursuing jobs in the science, tech, engineering, business, and social works fields.

Main Themes

Measurements, Areas and Volumes, Trigonometry, Exponents and Radicals, Polynomials, Functions and Linear Relations, Graphing Linear Equations, Systems of Equations

Expectations
