Tickets for this year's Recognition Ceremony should be purchased from the online payment system at Parkland. Each grad is allotted 4 free tickets and are then able to purchase an additional 4 tickets if they are needed. Confirmation of all tickets will be emailed to the grads school email address. Please note tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable. Order tickets through Ms. Gribling.


### Tickets for the Parkland Secondary School Recognition Ceremony, June 28, 2022
