

Grade 12 Assembly

Friday November 2, 2018

- Graduation Credits:
 - Student responsible for any changes that may impact graduation status

- Grade 12s completing Online Courses:
 - all required courses done through distributed learning schools must be 70% completed by May 1st to participate in the June 27th graduation ceremony

- Universities and Colleges:
 - universities: time to start applying for first round offers
 - universities: be aware of deadlines for supplemental applications, auditions, portfolios
 - Online courses may have specific completion deadlines; usually before end of school
 - permission / proxy

 - U of Toronto: appointments with advisor on Wednesday November 21st
 - UBC: advisor at Parkland on Thursday, November 22nd at lunch
 - U of Victoria: presentation on Tuesday December 4th at lunch

 - colleges: apply now; offers usually made to first applications received with completed requirements
 - University transfer: BC Transfer Guide www.bctransferguide.ca
 - www.educationplannerbc.ca

- Transcripts to apply for Admission:
 - most universities don't require paper transcripts for admission
 - signed and sealed official paper transcript – ask Mrs. Ford at front office

 - most universities provide online opportunity to self report grades for admission

- Electronic Transcripts from the Ministry of Education:
 - required by most universities and colleges to finalize their offers of admission & scholarships
 - go to the Ministry of Education's Transcripts and Certificate website at <http://www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca>.
 - P.E.N. (nine digit Personal Education Number) will be required
 - included on report cards in "STUDENT PEN" box
 - ask counsellor

- Entrance Scholarships; based on g.p.a. of admission courses; often no application required

- Ministry of Education Scholarships:
 - BC Excellence Scholarship
 - fifty five @ \$5000
 - well rounded student
 - demonstrated service and leadership, both at school and in their communities, and shown aptitude and commitment to their chosen career paths.
 - school nominates by February 15th, 2018
 - nominee submits application package by February 15th, 2019

 - BC Achievement Scholarship
 - eight thousand scholarships @ \$1250
 - top 8000 students' gpas from grades 10/11/12
 - no application required
 - August 31st 2019

 - District/Authority Scholarships (approximately forty \$1250 vouchers for Parkland)
 - Applied Skills
 - Community Services
 - Fine Arts
 - International Languages
 - Indigenous Languages and Culture
 - Physical Activity
 - Technical and Trades Training
 - application forms available at Parkland in semester two

 - Pathway to Teacher Education Scholarship
 - twenty @ \$5000
 - attend BC faculty of education to train as K -12 teacher
 - student application deadline: February 15th 2019

 - International Ambassador Scholarships
 - \$1250 available to an international student

- Secondary School Apprenticeship Scholarship
 - To be eligible for SSA scholarships, ITA registered apprentices must have:
 - been registered with the Industry Training Authority as a youth apprentice;
 - graduated with a Grade 12 Dogwood Diploma or Adult Dogwood;
 - successfully completed SSA 11A, SSA 11B, SSA 12A, and SSA 12B no later than three months after graduation;
 - maintained a C+ average or better on all Grade 12 numbered courses;
and
 - reported a minimum of 900 hours to the ITA within six months of secondary school graduation.
