- Graduation Credits List:
 - Indicates students with missing “required” course or courses to graduate
 - Posted on Mr. Choo’s office door
 - Posted on Graduate Bulletin Board, Math, Chemistry and Physics rooms

- Grade 12s Online Course List:
 - indicates students with required course(s) timetabled as an online (e.g., SIDES) course
 - all required courses done through distributed learning schools must be 70% completed by May 1st to participate in the June 27th graduation ceremony

- Transcripts to apply for Admission:
 - most universities don’t require paper transcripts for admission
 - most universities provide online opportunity to self report grades for admission
 - signed and sealed official paper transcript – ask Mrs. Ford at front office
 - unofficial paper transcript – ask Mr. Choo
 - pdf of transcript – ask Mr. Choo

- Electronic Transcripts from the Ministry of Education:
 - required by most universities and colleges to finalize their offers of admission & scholarships
 - go to the Ministry of Education’s Transcripts and Certificate website at <http://www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca>.
 - P.E.N. (nine digit Personal Education Number) will be required
 - included on report cards in “STUDENT PEN” box
 - ask counsellor

- Universities and Colleges:
 - universities: time to start applying for first round offers
 - universities: be aware of deadlines for supplemental applications, auditions, portfolios
 - U of Vic: accelerated business diploma
 - U of Toronto: appointments with advisor on Nov. 30th
 - colleges: apply now; offers usually made to first applications received with completed requirements
 - Camosun College: admission requirements for nursing have changed again
 - Camosun College: offer of advisor to visit to speak about BSc of Nursing before deadline
 - Online courses may have specific completion deadlines; usually before end of school

- Entrance Scholarships

- Ministry of Education Scholarships:
 - BC Excellence Scholarship
 - (fifty five @ \$5000)
 - well rounded student
 - demonstrated service and leadership, both at school and in their communities, and shown aptitude and commitment to their chosen career paths.
 - school nominates by February 15th, 2018
 - nominee submits application package by February 15th, 2018

 - BC Achievement Scholarship
 - eight thousand scholarships @ \$1250
 - top 8000 students' gpas from grades 10/11/12
 - no application required

 - District/Authority Scholarships (approximately forty \$1250 vouchers for Parkland)
 - Applied Skills
 - Community Services
 - Fine Arts
 - International Languages
 - Indigenous Languages and Culture
 - Physical Activity
 - Technical and Trades Training
 - application forms available at Parkland in semester two

 - Pathway to Teacher Education Scholarship
 - twenty @ \$5000
 - attend BC faculty of education to train as K -12 teacher
 - student application deadline: February 15th 2018
