Math 11: Apprenticeship & Workplace

- Accepted as a prerequisite for trades courses
- Not accepted as math 11 requirement for most university and college courses*

*Uvic fine arts

Math 11: Foundations

Admission requirement at many universities and colleges for:

- Child and Youth Care / Social Work
- Fine Arts (e.g., Theater, Music, Visual Arts, Writing)
- Humanities (e.g., Linguistics, History, French)
- Social Sciences (e.g., Psychology, Political Science)

Math 11: Pre-Calculus

Accepted as admission requirement at many universities and colleges for:

- Child and Youth Care
- Humanities
- Performing & Visual Arts
- Social Sciences
- Social Work

Math 12: Pre-Calculus

- Standard university requirement for:
 - Business
 - Engineering
 - Sciences
- *Standard college requirement for:*
 - *Engineering*
 - *Sciences including Pre-medicine*

Business

Uvic admission requirements (80% - 85%):

- English 12
- Math Pre-calculus 12
- Academic 12 #1
- Academic 12 #2

Camosun College admission requirements:

- *English 12 (67%)*
- *Math Pre-Calculus 11 (60%) or*
- *Foundations of Math 11 (60%)*

not mandatory for admission but must be completed in first semester at CC.

UVic admission requirements (85% - 90%):

- Chemistry 11, Physics 11,
- English 12, Math Pre-calculus 12,
- Physics 12 and a second Science 12
- (Chemistry 12 recommended)

Camosun College admission requirements:

- *English 12 (60%+) and Math Pre-Calculus 12 (67%+)*
- *Chemistry 11 (60%+) and Physics 12 (60%+)*

Biology

UVic admission requirements (78% - 82%):

- Chemistry 11, Physics 11,
- English 12 and Math Pre-calculus 12
- two Science 12s
- Biology 12, Chemistry 12 and Physics 12 for some programs¹

Camosun College admission requirements:

- *English 12 (67%+) and Math Pre-Calculus 11 (67%+)*
- *One Science 12 (60%+)*

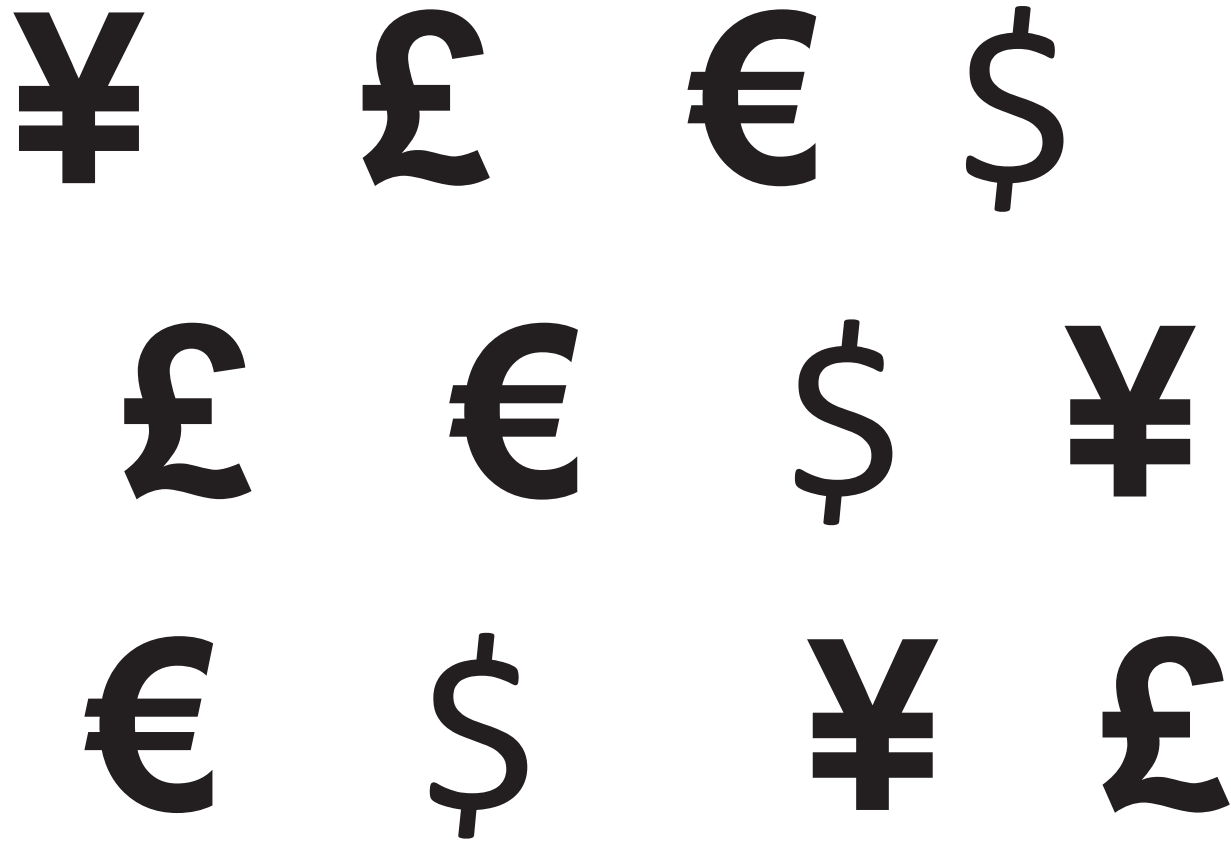
Admission versus Prerequisites

- Admission requirements to a faculty may not satisfy prerequisites for specific courses.
- e.g., **Biology at UVic**
- **Faculty of Science requires two (2) science 12s however**
- **Program for first year studies in Biology requires Biology 12, Chemistry 12 & Physics 12 as prerequisites**

Planning Tips

- Admission often starts in September
- UBC: admission courses completed in semester one
- Second language required at SFU and UBC
- Camosun College's BAET: currently 2 year waitlist
- EN12 in first semester may be an advantage
- Avoid online alternatives for required courses

SCHOLARSHIPS



Scholarships

- Available throughout year
- Major scholarships in fall
- University entrance at self reporting
- Parkland internal scholarships in April
- Many others

Major Community Scholarships

- LORAN
October: up to \$100,000
- TD/Canada Trust
November: up to \$70,000
- Schulich Leader
February: up to \$80,000

University Entrance Scholarships

- Often decided by the self reported grades for EN12 and three (or four) Academic 12 courses required for admission.
- Often decided when grade 12 courses required for admission are self reported.

Parkland Internal Scholarships*

- available only to a Canadian Parkland graduate:
- forty (40) District Authority @ \$1250
- Community Service Applied Skills
- International Languages Fine Arts
- Indigenous Cultures Physical Activity
- Trades
- 3 for future teachers; 1 for future nurse
